# "Research at the Malaghan and the Covid-19 response" Professor Mike Berridge BSc, MSc (Hons), PhD (Auckland)

Mike is the Cancer Cell Biology Group Leader at Malaghan. He completed a doctoral degree in cell biology in Auckland in 1971. He researched molecular biology at Purdue University, USA, and worked at the National Institute for Medical Research, Mill Hill, UK, before returning to Wellington in 1976 to establish the Cancer Cell Biology Research Group.

We will accept donations at the meeting for the Malaghan's work on cancer research.

Welcome to Ray Manning newly elected Vice President.


#### Secretary and Treasurer

We are very fortunate to welcome back Secretary, Brenda Baker and Treasurer Leah Herd.







## **Survey of Members**


