## Walking & local history report

The last day of April gave us a lovely autumn day for the Local History Group's trip to the inner city. We walked up through Cuba Mall and into Upper Cuba Street, reminiscing about places long gone and admiring the architecture of the early 20th century, still visible above the shop verandas in much of Cuba Street.

Tonks Grove is a small historic precinct off Upper Cuba Street, containing houses that were relocated from Tonks Avenue, the street which disappeared when the Inner City Bypass was constructed. It is easy to drive along Karo Drive, intent on reaching the motorway, and not notice the fine old houses that grace the northern side of the street. Coming, as we do, from Lower Hutt's suburbia, we wondered what it would be like to live so close to the city centre.
