May Speaker Dr Chris Massey



Dr Massey is an engineering geologist from GNS who will talk about land slips.

Dr. Massey has researched complex

geological and geotechnical data for slope stability. This includes landslide monitoring, foundation design, underground/surface rock support and groundwater problems.

He has applied these skills to geohazard risk analyses and assessments, and to oil and gas pipelines, as well as highway, railway, mining engineering and town planning projects in Africa, the Himalayas, Europe, South East and Central Asia and Australasia.

Dr Massey's research interests are in rock mechanics, engineering geomorphology and in particular, landslide processes and mechanisms of movement. He has published many peer-reviewed journal papers and has given lectures and workshops around the world.

Last month's speaker NIWA's Dr Sam Dean

Dr Dean spoke of the contribution of human-induced warming to intensifying current New Zealand weather extremes, including droughts and floods. It was particularly



sobering to see a graph over hundreds of years which showed how recently this has taken place.

Dr Dean has a broad and comprehensive knowledge of climate change impacts on New Zealand. Over past 13 years he has been at the forefront of developing future climate change projections specifically for New Zealand.

These projections are actively used by numerous research institutes, government departments and local government councils to better understand, and plan for, the impacts of climate change. In recent years he has contributed to adaptation solutions to expected climate change impacts.
